# **Callaway Property Annexation**

- Attorney Ron Pritzke, representing CalAtlantic, was sworn in. The CalAtlantic representatives were also present. This annexation is the additional real estate (Calloway property) that will enable the relocation of the McCord Pointe subdivision's entrance. It is 46 acres. The project will go to the McCordsville Plan Commission next and has been advertised and notices sent to adjoining landowners. This acreage means an additional 112 lots will be added to the McCord Pointe development. Two acres are being reserved for Town use. The development also has an amenity area.
  - o Mr. Strayer: Will it require a vacation of McCord Road? Per Mr. Morelock, not at this point.
  - Mr. Strayer: Are there concerns about what will happen to McCord Road? Per Mr. Witsman, no.
  - Mr. Strayer: Is the roundabout big enough for fire trucks? Per Mr. Witsman, this has not been evaluated yet.

- Mr. Longman: Has signage been addressed? Per Mr. Crum, new signage has not been addressed yet.
- Mr. Wood: Are McCord Road residents aware of the new design? Per Mr. Crum, they have been notified.
