Re: Town Standards revisions

Public Works:

Below is a list of revisions to the McCordsville Town Standards. The revisions are markups of the existing PDF files. The revisions have to be approved by Town Council.

- 1. Sheet 1 Title sheet
 - a. Update of revision log.
- 2. Sheet 2 Pavement Specifications
 - a. Revision to the lime stabilization specification by modifying the range call out to a specific value of lime.
 - b. Revision to the lime stabilization specification by adding written acceptance of cement stabilization as a lime alternative.
 - c. Revision to the lime stabilization specification to make clearer that quicklime shall not be allowed.
 - d. Revision to the multi-use path pavement section to allow for installation in single pass by changing the pavement section to one 3" lift instead of a two lifts (2" intermediate and 1" surface).
 - e. All road pavement sections modified to match INDOT change to minimum 1.5" asphalt surface layer.
 - f. Correction to local collector name.
 - g. Added written temperature requirements.
- 3. Sheet 3 Right of Way Details
 - a. Revision to underdrain detail.
- 4. Sheet 4 Utility Location Guidelines

McCordsville

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- a. Revision to right of way width.
- 5. Sheet 5 Driveway and handicap ramp details
 - a. Revision to handicap ramps to match INDOT standards.
- 6. Sheet 6 Storm sewer structure details
 - a. Note added to storm manhole details
 - b. Note added to catch basin detail
 - c. Televising language added for clarity.
 - d. Alternate castings from East Jordan added.
- 7. Sheet 7 Storm sewer bedding details and general notes
 - a. Note added to end section detail
 - b. Note added to swale underdrain detail
 - c. Notes added to subsurface drain riser detail
- 8. Sheet 10 Sanitary sewer lift station standards & guidelines
 - a. Change pump manufacturer.
