ORDINANCE NO. 021324

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MCCORDSVILLE, INDIANA ALLOWING PRE-APPROVED PAYMENT OF CLAIMS

WHEREAS, the Town of McCordsville (the "Town") is a political subdivision existing under the provisions of Indiana law;

WHEREAS, the Town of McCordsville Council (the "Council") is the legislative body of the Town;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code sections 36-5-4-12 and 5-11-10-1.6, the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town may make claim payments in advance of approval by the Town Council for certain types of expenses;

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1992, Council adopted Ordinance 91292, which was later amended on September 19, 2000, allowing the Clerk-Treasurer to make certain payments in advance of Council approval;

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to amend the Town's ordinance to affirm the preapproval for payment of claims to include other categories where the Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to make claim payments in advance of Council approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MCCORDSVILLE, INDIANA:

- 1. The Clerk-Treasurer of the Town is hereby authorized to make claim payments in advance of council allowance for the following kinds of expenses:
 - (a) Property or services purchased or leased from:
 - (i) the United States government; or
 - (ii) an agency or a political subdivision of the United States government;
 - (b) License fees or permit fees;
 - (c) Insurance premiums;
 - (d) Utility payments or utility connection charges;
 - (e) Federal grant programs if:
 - (i) advance funding is not prohibited; and
 - (ii) the contracting party provides sufficient security for the amount advanced;
 - (f) Grants of state funds authorized by statute;
 - (g) Maintenance agreements or service agreements;
 - (h) Lease agreements or rental agreements;
 - (i) Principal and interest payments on bonds and associated fees;
 - (j) Payroll and all employee funds withheld from his/her pay;
 - (k) State, federal, or county taxes;

- (l) Expenses that must be paid because of emergency circumstances;
- (m) Expenses described in any ordinance;
- (n) Fuel bills;
- (o) Any claim that will incur a late charge if its due date falls before a scheduled Town Council meeting.
- 2. The Clerk-Treasurer of the Town is also hereby authorized to make claim payments in advance of council allowance in accordance with Indiana Code section 5-11-10-1.6, as amended. Those include:
- A. Advance payments to contractors to enable the contractors to purchase materials needed for a public works project for the Town, so long as the amount does not exceed the lesser of the following:
 - (i) Fifty percent (50%) of the entire cost of the contract.
 - (ii) Two million dollars (\$2,000,000).

The solicitation for the public works contract providing for advance payment for contractors must include the following information:

- (i) That the political subdivision will make advance payments to contractors to enable contractors to purchase materials.
- (ii) Any limitations on the amount of advance payments that will be made.
- (iii) Requirements for documentation relating to making advance payments to contractors for materials.
- (iv) Any other information about advance payment for materials the political subdivision considers useful to contractors that make offers.
- B. Advance payments for goods or services before the goods are delivered or services are completed, so long as the amount does not exceed the lesser of the following:
 - (i) Fifty percent (50%) of the entire cost of the contract.
 - (ii) Two million dollars (\$2,000,000).

The Clerk-Treasurer and/or her designee must do all of the following when advance payments are made:

- (i) Track prepayments by defining the prepayment on a purchase order.
- (ii) Create a prepayment invoice that is associated with the purchase order.
- (iii) Require insurance or a surety bond in the amount of the prepayment if the amount of the prepayment is more than one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000).
- 3. Each payment of expenses under this Ordinance must be supported by a fully itemized invoice or bill and certification by the Clerk-Treasurer.
- 4. The Town Council shall review and allow the claim at its next regular or special meeting following the preapproved payment of the expense.
 - 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
