- February 27: Preliminary RFP Adopted by BPW (Initiates Process; Services Requested are not Final)
- March: Contractors Review RFP and Submit Questions
- April: Final RFP Adopted by BPW
- April- June: Proposals Submitted by Contractors
- June- July: Negotiation Period with Offerors
- July: BPW Awards Contract
- August- October: Council Adopts Ordinance to Solidify the Trash Rate
- **Q1 2025:** Services Project to Begin (Pending Responses Received, Mobilization Times, Etc.)

Summary of services in preliminary RFP (subject to change)

Baseline RFP

- 2 Containers—1 Provided—2 Upon Request
- Out of City Residents can pause service to not be charged
- Recycling Biweekly (alternate option for every week)
- Customers can purchase overage bags/bulk waste tags directly from contractor
- Special Needs Service for Elderly and Special Needs

Alternate #1: Compost and Leaf Pick Up

- Leaf Pickup March Apil May October November December (20 Bags)
- Composting,
- Christmas Tree

Alternate #2: Bulky Waste

• 1 bulk item per month

Alternate #3: Resident Drop Off Program

• Resident billed directly from contractor for drop off of additional items at identified area

Alternate #4: City Facility Trash Collection

Additional Notes:

- Billing likely to be handled by the City
- Operations handled by the Contractor
- We have language that indicates we are open to discuss billing option through the contractor.
- Contractor assumes risk of underpayment by residents. City will in good faith effort collect the monthly trash fees from residents.
