Committee & Staff Reports

- Parks Board: Did not meet.
- Redevelopment Commission: Did not meet.
- **Vernon Township Fire Committee**: They passed two resolutions, the growth appeal and the updated budget.
- Metropolitan Police Board: They swore in a new officer, Officer Kwon, and they renewed their contract for the body worn cameras. Mr. Jones reminded everyone that Community Day will be on August 15th starting at 5pm.
- <u>Public Works Committee</u>: They reported that the 600 and 600 roundabout construction has begun and that they are estimating a completion date in late fall. They also reviewed an invoice for stoplight improvements that will appear on the consent agenda, and they approved an appraisal invoice for Railroad Street.
- Architectural Review Committee: At the first meeting on June 17^{th,} old business was Fischer Homes request for recommendation on a product lineup at Lain Farms which was continued. Under new business, they approved MAP McCord LLC's request for approval of the exterior design for Starbucks. They also reviewed MI Homes' request for changes to architectural design standards at Helm's Mill and Rockport, which brought forward a compromise to be discussed later at the Council Meeting. They also approved Davis Homes' request for approval of an exterior design at Enclave at Deer Crossing, with conditions. They approved the Town's





request for approval of exterior elevations at the new Community Center and then Fisher Homes' request for approval of additional lots at Hampton Walk was continued. Pulte Homes' request for recommendation on product lineup at Jacobi Farms and Taylor Morrison's request for recommendation on changes to their product lineup at Colonnade were both continued. At the special meeting they met July 1^{st,} and after much deliberation they approved enough elevations for Jacobi Farms to build out the subdivision. Taylor Morrison's request was approved as presented.

• <u>Plan Commission:</u> They had six items under new business beginning with an approval for the replat of Starbucks as well as an approval of Arbor Homes' request for approval of a primary plat. They also reviewed three items regarding Patch Development.

Consent Agenda

- The consent agenda included the CenterPoint Gas Main Extension Agreement, Signal Construction Quote, Colonnade Sewer Developer Agreement, and the Clerk-Treasurer's Report.
- Dr. Burney questioned the turn lanes on item B. Mr. Witsman explained how the sensors work for the cameras.

- Dr. Burney described an alternative option for how to construct the traffic light at a cheaper price and a more productive way to queue up traffic.
- Mr. Witsman stated that they have constructed a study, and the Town is now obligated to continue with the plan that was set forth and install the signal at the intersection as designed.

- Mr. Gropp explained that they are planning a Movie in the Park for July 18th, and the Path to Fitness is on August 9th. He also explained that they are pushing out communication regarding the construction at 600 & 600. Mr. Gropp also explained that Old School Park is still not open, but they are working through the punch list. The Town Hall Renovation is also moving along nicely as well as the Community Center renovation.
- Mr. Brewer asked Mr. Gropp to explain why the signage is down at the new Police Department.
- Mr. Witsman gave an update on the street mill and re-surface throughout Town.

Town Councilor Comments

• Dr. Burney commented that the sewer connection has begun at Champion Lake. He also commended Dr. Parker and his work with the school district while not raising the tax rate.
