CR 500W Over CSX Railroad & US 36/SR 67 (Broadway)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Parsons Transportation Group (Consultant) will develop conceptual level designs for a new overpass structure and realignment of CR 500W. The alternatives will include connecting roadways to US 36/SR 67 (Broadway). A report of findings will include cost estimates and identification of an initial recommended alternative.

- 2. Two alternative alignments will be developed.
- 3. Schedule includes a 30-day review of the Draft Report



SECTION A: CONCEPTUAL DESIGN

OBJECTIVE

The Consultant will develop recommendations for the realignment of CR 500W and overpass over CSX Railroad and US 36/SR 67 (Broadway) with associated connecting roadways.

ACTIVITY

The Consultant will perform the following activities as part of this section:

Conceptual Engineering Report

- 1. Evaluate one alternative alignment.
- 2. Conceptual level right-of-way limits will be identified.
- 3. Develop rough order of magnitude of project cost.
- 4. Plan view of proposed improvements on GIS aerial.

BASIS OF SCOPE

- 1. No traffic data collection nor traffic analysis will be performed.
- 2. No field investigation of existing resources will be conducted.
- 3. Designs will be developed to a conceptual level (10%)
- 4. No coordination will be performed with the Indiana Department of Transportation or Hancock County.
- 5. No design calculations will be performed beyond those required to develop alternative alignments and profiles.
