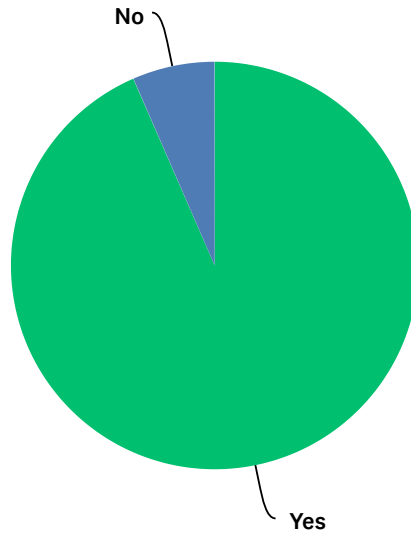


Q1 The ball field is used for practices by local clubs. Should that be continued?

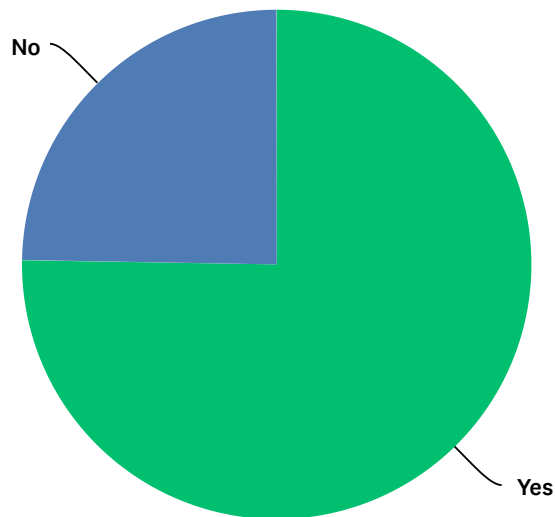

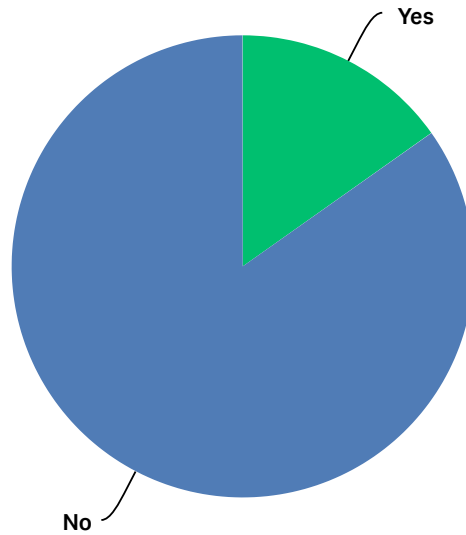

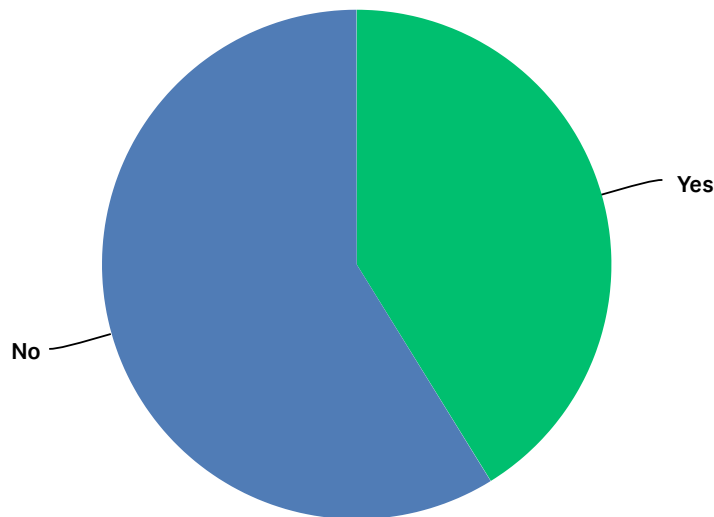

Q5 Would you support the tennis courts transition to Futsal Courts with the understanding it will be maintained by the Geist Area Soccer League (GASL?)

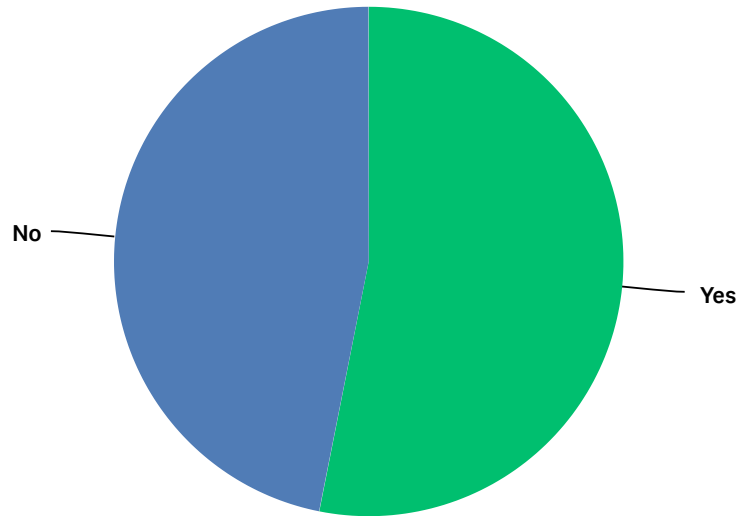

Q6 Would you support the tennis courts transition to Pickleball Courts (Pickleball)?

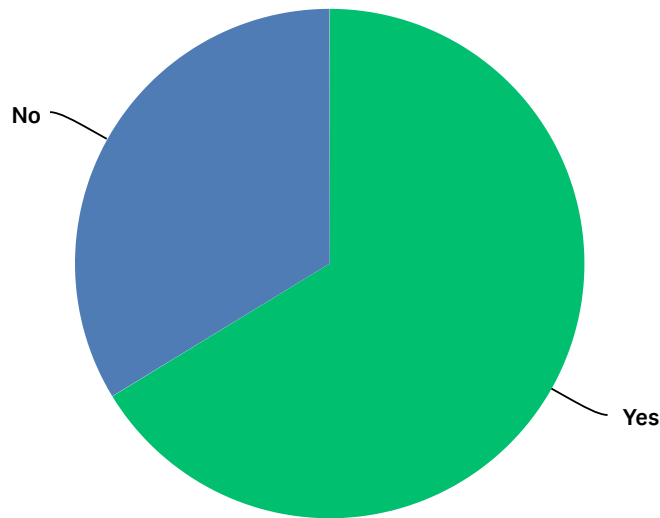

Q7 Do you want the tennis courts to remain?

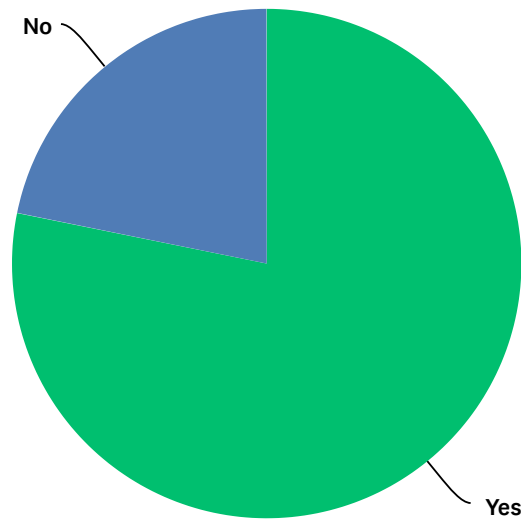

Q8 Should the tennis courts be lighted?

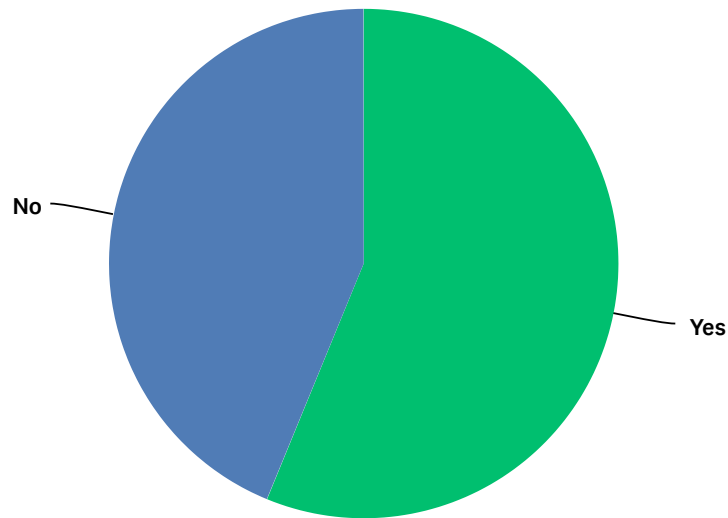

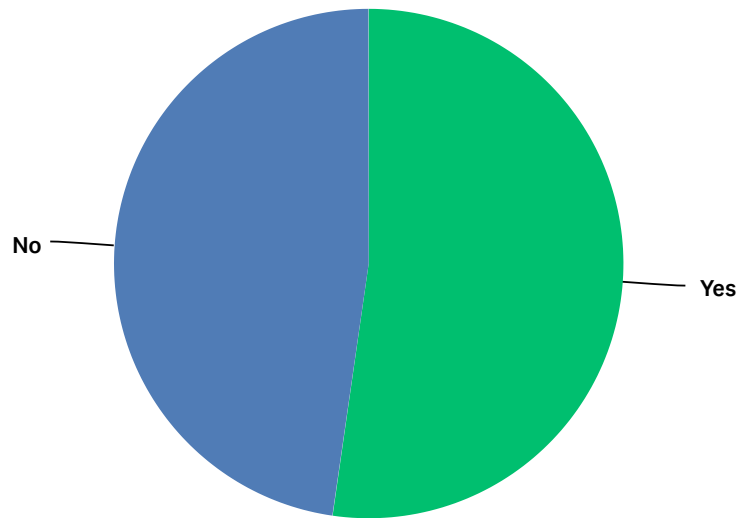

Q15 Should WIFI at the Park be provided?

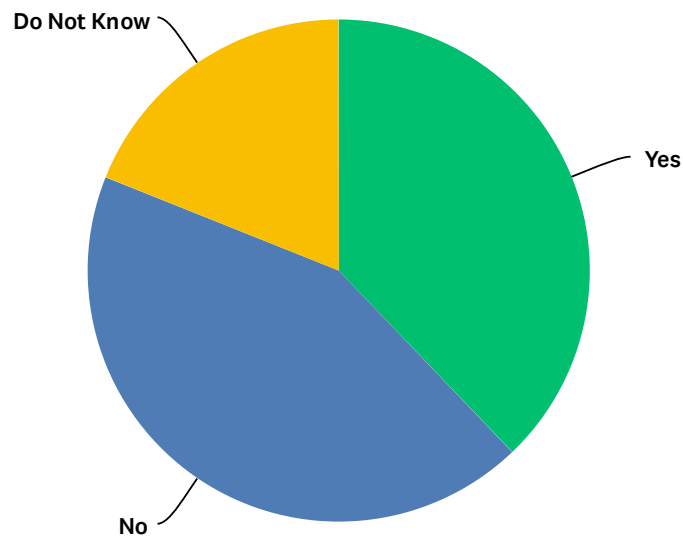

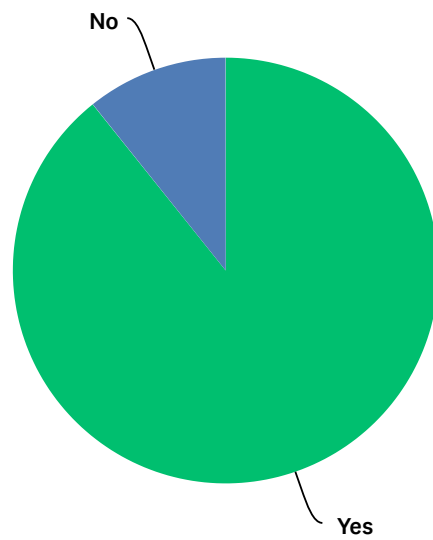

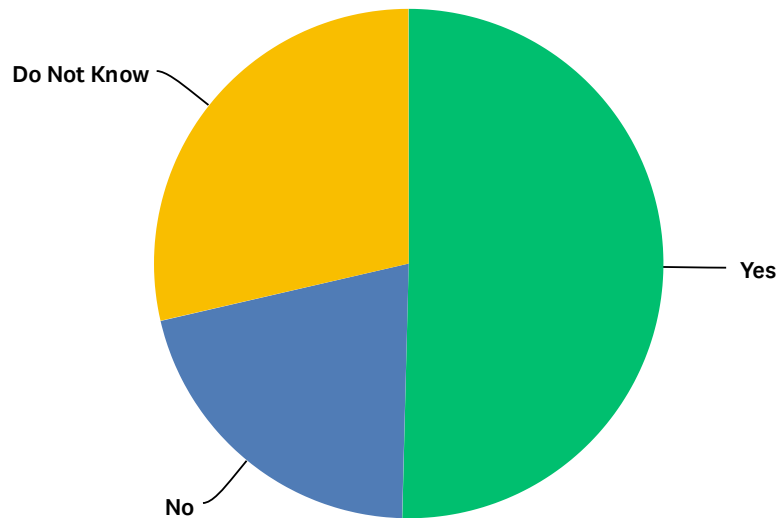
