Phase 1: Pass Special Legislation by March 2020; Funding in place by Summer 2022

- 1. Evolve from existing and unsustainable volunteer funding situation
- 2. Use Buck Creek Fire Department funding model
- 3. Sustainable 24/7 on station manpower coverage at Station #3 (Fortville)
- 4. Professional management model; still requires part-time and paid per run
- 5. Includes Fire Marshal and Fire Admin
- 6. May allow improvements in manpower on station in McCordsville but doesn't fully fund second station model
- 7. Find land and develop 24/7 station plan for McCordsville
- 8. Engage the Town of McCordsville, Town of Fortville, Mt Vernon School Corporation and the County Council & Commission via Vernon Township Fire Task Force and leadership/council meetings.

Phase 2: Determine appropriate size and structure for Fire Territory; Timing TBD w/ Phase 1.

- 1. Begin study of future needs in coordination with our neighbors.
- 2. Study Fire Territory structure and financial needs in early 2021.
- 3. Determine appropriate population base, industrial mix and partner municipalities. (note: DLGF Commissioner noted that Plainfield size and mix territory appears to hit the magic proportions; has not shared analysis yet)
- 4. Implement Fire Territory structure with appropriate municipal partners.
