Re: **Expected Revenue Shortfall for MVH and LRS**

Dear Councilors:

Staff has been alerted of some expected decreases in both gas tax revenues and property tax revenues all related to COVID-19 impacts to gas tax revenues and property tax revenue impacts like 2008 recession impacts. Below is a simplified budget from both MHV and LRS for 2020 and what the expected financial impacts from COVID-19.
