Approval of Minutes-December 1, 2020 meeting minutes

Recycling Bins (signage and policy)-Ron Crider/Tonya Galbraith

The issue of the recycling bins filling and abuse with dumping was presented. The bins have been full, and residents continue to add recycling beside and behind the bins. It has turned into extra work and expense for Public Works Crew and CGS. The past few days the gate has been shut when full and a temporary sign posted that the bins are full, and the area has closed. Ms. Galbraith has posted on social media and the Town of McCordsville webpage that the gates would close when full. It was discussed whether anything further should be done and verbiage if new signs are made. More bins would be an additional charge for residents. Mr. Strayer brought up whether an ordinance should be drafted. It was decided that closing the gate when the bins were full is working for now and a possible new sign is in the works.

Sewer Request for 9093 N. McCord Road-Mark Witsman

A letter was received from Tony Keaton, 9093 N McCord Road requesting sewer connection service to his property from the Town of McCordsville. Mr. Witsman said that this area is a part of a sewer territory and part of a long-term plan. Mr. Witsman gave the general scope of plan to possibly provide service for other homes along W 900 N.

Public Works advised Mr. Keaton to contact the other residents involved to see if there is any interest in being added to the towns sewer and set up a meeting with staff. Mr. Keaton said he will report back at the February Public Works meeting.
