Silverthorne Homes' request for a Development Standards Variance to allow a reduction in the minimum building separation on Lot 4 in Stone Grove

The foundation for the home on lot 4 was accidentally poured too close to the property line, resulting in a 14'9" separation between the homes instead of the required 15'. The petitioners are asking for a four (4) inch variance so they do not have to tear out the foundation and cause further delay to the construction timeline.

Mr. Karn asked if the petitioner had consulted the next door neighbor. Mark Moss of Silverthorne stated they were waiting on the outcome of the meeting to discuss it with them. Mr. Morelock stated that since the title was still in Silverthorne's name, legally they did not need to contact the buyer.

Mr. Crum stated that Staff supports variance and does not think there it is a detriment to the development standards.
