WHEREAS, the Town of McCordsville desires to adopt a Fiscal Plan and a definite policy for the provision of services to annexed areas; and

WHEREAS, such a Plan has been developed and presented to the Town of McCordsville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of McCordsville, Indiana, that:

- 1. The Town of McCordsville hereby approves and adopts the "Fiscal Plan", which Plan is attached hereto and made a part hereof and hereby approves and adopts the specific policies for implementation of the Plan as set out therein.
- 2. Any monies necessary for the provision of services as described and itemized in the attached Plan shall be budgeted and appropriated from the applicable fund pursuant to State law and the Town's budgetary procedure.
- 3. It is anticipated that this annexation will not result in the elimination of jobs for employees of other governmental entities, but in the event it does, then the Town of McCordsville shall assist such employees in obtaining new employment, but nothing herein shall require the Town to hire any such employees.
