Municipal Building Corporation Meeting Minutes

Monday April 17, 2023

Opening and Roll Call:

Town Manager Tim Gropp called the meeting to order at 5:31 pm. He stated this is the first meeting of the Municipal Building Corporation and he will hand the meeting over once officers are elected.

Election Of Officers

Mrs. Price made a motion to appoint Dr. Burney as President. A second was made by Mr. Longman and passed 3/0.

Dr. Burney made a motion to appoint Mr. Longman as Vice President. A second was made by Mrs. Price and passed 3/0.

Mr. Longman made a motion to appoint Mrs. Price as Secretary/Treasurer. A second was made by Dr. Burney and passed 3/0.

Dr. Burney officially took over, leading the meeting.

Review of Purpose and Responsibilities:

- Dennis Otten reviewed the forming documents that his firm drafted and filed including the
 Articles of Incorporation and Certificate of Incorporation. He stated that this is a 63-20
 Corporation that was initially formed to hold the property for the new McCordsville Police
 Station during the term of the bond.
- The Federal Tax ID is the same as the Town of McCordsville
- Bose McKinney is currently handling the yearly filings (\$25) with the State. Some discussion was held to determine if it was worth the Town handling this internally in the future to save a little money.
- Dennis reviewed the process of Appointing Members as outlined in the Articles of Incorporation.
- The by-laws still needed some tweaks so those will be presented for approval at the next meeting. This will include a section for electronic signature.
- It was determined the Municipal Building Corporation will use July as their regular annual meeting month. This will be incorporated into the by-laws.

Police Station Bond Timeline

 Dennis walked through the Police Station Bond timeline. The next meeting will need to be scheduled for May 9th along with the Economic Development Commission to meet the deadlines.

- Mr. Otten also discussed the form of lease for the Police Station project. No action was needed at this time.
- Mrs. Price indicated she may not be able to attend. It was determined she could review the documents and Mr. Otten could hold the signature in escrow if needed until a formal vote has taken place.
- It was confirmed that the next meeting would be held on May 9th at 5:00 pm followed by the Economic Development Commission at 5:30 pm.
