Mr. Phillips confirmed that all Architectural Standards in the PUD would be met and stated that the builder and that the builder would add a garage bump-out.

Caitlin Dopher appeared for the petitioner. Mr. Crum presented the Staff Review and asked Ms. Dopher to confirm that the PUD requirements will be met. Ms. Dopher listed the changes that had been made to the elevations and confirmed that all PUD requirements will be met. After some discussion, Ms. Dopher agreed to exclude the Eisenhower Tudor elevation from the line-up.
