

Safety Signal

- Create A Special Signal That Alerts A Neighbor To Call Police.
- Create A Special Signal That Alerts Children To Exit The Home.

Safety Plan For Children To Exit Home

- Teach The Children Their Home Phone Number.
- Teach The Children Their Home Address.
- Make Arrangements With A Neighbor / Friend Willing To Watch Children For Extended Period.

Have Bags Packed And Ready For Immediate Exit (Include The Following Items If Possible)

- Change of clothes for yourself and your children.
- Address Book—include phone numbers of friends, relatives, doctors, and lawyers.
- Money—including change for a pay phone.
- Extra Keys for both house and cars.
- Emergency medicines.
- Important papers—including checking and savings account numbers; copy of lease or deed; copy of No Violent Contact Order / Protective Order; birth certificates; social security numbers for yourself, your children and your partner; TANF/SSI/Medicaid Cards, etc.

REMEMBER: Avoid long distance calls if possible (long distance calls can be traced). Advise school system, court, welfare, etc. of the situation and remind them <u>NOT</u> to give out any information.
