II. Nominations for Officers of the Commission

- b.) Motion by William Benson to nominate Charles Meggenhofen as Vice-President of the Board of Police Commissioners. 2nd by Claude Robinson. Passes 5-o.
- c.) Motion by William Benson to nominate Wade Apel as Secretary of the Board of Police Commissioners. 2nd by Mark Walker. Passes 5-0.

V. Discussion – Chief Rodgers

- a.) Discussion held pertaining to Commissioners usage of personal computers or phones to access Power DMS and town email.
- b.) Chief Rodgers discussed the Commissioners responsibility to review and approve policies.
- c.) Chief Rodgers provided the Commissioners with the Rules and Procedures.

- d.) Chief Rodgers discussed the reasons for implementing the McCordsville Metropolitan Board of Police Commissioners.
- e.) Chief Rodgers discussed 1977 Police Officers' and Firefighters' Retirement Fund and the next steps of the process.
- f.) Chief Rodgers discussed confidentiality and the Open Door Law with Commissioners.
- g.) Chief Rodgers discussed his personal background and history of Police Department.

VII. Police Department Rank Structure and Staffing – Chief Rodgers

- a.) Chief Rodgers discussed the Police Department's current rank structure:
 - i. Chief of Police, Assistant Chief of Police, Night Shift Lieutenant, Day Shift Sergeant and Patrol Personnel
- b.) Chief Rodgers discussed the Police Department's current staffing information:
 - Three FTO's (Field Training Officer), One Training Supervisor / Day Shift Sergeant, Two Evidence Technicians and One Detective
 - ii. Minimum staffing requirement is one officer per shift and the ideal man power is three officers per shift
 - iii. Two officers will be attending the academy in June of 2018

VIII. Future Board Meetings

- a.) President Mark Walker set the next meeting for June 18, 2018 at 7:00 pm. The meeting will be held in the Council Chambers located in the McCordsville Town Hall Building.
- b.) President Mark Walker tabled the remainder of this year's meetings dates. The matter will be revisited at the next meeting in June.

IX. Budget Discussion – Chief Rodgers

- a.) Chief Rodgers asked for two Commissioners and one at the very least, that would be willing to serve on a committee with Chief Rodgers, Major Casey, Councilman Burney and Clerk Treasurer to look at the budget.
- b.) Chief Rodgers advised the elementary school is wanting a School Resource Officer and Major Casey has started putting together preliminary numbers.

X. Vehicle Donation – Chief Rodgers

a.) The Police Department is donating one vehicle to the Town of Green Fork, Indiana Police Department. The Police Department had two vehicles and one vehicle lost a motor. The Town of Green Fork had a crippling event with their Waste Water Treatment Plant and had to divert all their Rainy-Day Funds. The vehicle will be donated on May 18, 2018 and the Commissioners were invited to attend. The McCordsville Town Council approved the vehicle donation.

XI. Commissioners Meeting Compensation - Chief Rodgers

a.) Discussion held regarding the compensation of Commissioners which was approved by the McCordsville Town Council.

XII. Other Business – Chief Rodgers

- a.) Discussion held regarding accessing email on personal phones.
- b.) Ms. Messer scanned approximately 50 banker boxes of arrest records into Docuware.
- c.) Interact contract signed three years ago and discussion held about the benefits.
- d.) Discussion held concerning identification cards and police department electronic access cards for the Commissioners. No decision was made.
- e.) Chief Rodgers introduced Officer Jessica Barnes. Officer Barnes is now an Instructor and one of the Department's strongest Field Training Officer.
- f.) Chief Rodgers introduced Officer Ryan Bowersox. Officer Bowersox recently held Coffee with a Cop Event at Meijer and is currently planning another event with Meijer.
- g.) Tonya Galbraith, Officer Bowersox and Ms. Messer are planning National Night Out Event.
