



CART PLACEMENT

- All items must be bagged and placed in the cart to be collected. During holidays excess garbage can be placed next to the cart.
- Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from the curb.
- There needs to be at least five (5) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.

CURBSIDE GARBAGE SERVICE INFORMATION

- New residents, your trash service is automatically started through the town. Contact CGS (1-800-453-5575) for toter delivery.
- Carts are for trash service only, not recycling.
- Start date is January 1, 2019, refer to **Holiday Schedule**.
- Service day will be **every Wednesday**.
- Place all trash at the curb by 6:00 am on Wednesday.
- If you are currently renting a toter from CGS, please call our office (1-800-453-5575), this fee will be waived, as the first toter of this program is provided at no charge.
- If you already own a CGS toter, you will not be delivered one. If you would like an additional toter, please request one by calling CGS (1-800-453-5575), for \$3.50 / month additional fee for each additional toter.
- Any residents who currently have a toter / receptacle that meets ANSI standards for automated trash collection, can be used. If your toter / receptacle meets these standards and you wish to have the new CGS toter removed, please contact our office. CGS is not responsible for any damage to non-CGS toter / receptacles, but they will be replaced with a new CGS 95 gal toter.
- “Tag a Bag” and “Bulk Item” sticker programs are still available and can be purchased at Town Hall or call CGS.
- “Tag a Bag” stickers are \$1.00 each per sticker per bag.
- **Bulk Items:** Residents are allowed one bulk item per month - **the first Wednesday of every month**. A bulk item is defined as something that can not fit properly into a trash bag or which exceeds (50) pounds in weight. A bulk item shall include, but is not limited to: chair / recliner, couch (no sleeper bed couches), washer, dryer, dishwasher, range / stove, etc. Mattresses (Queen or smaller) will be accepted. All mattresses must be wrapped in plastic and sealed with duct tape. If you have additional bulk items over and above the one per month, you can purchase stickers at Town Hall in advance for additional bulk pick up service. Each sticker will be \$15.00. Limit - (2) bulk items per pick up.
- **Building materials will not be accepted.**
- **Holidays:** New Year’s Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day. If your service falls on or after one of the above listed Holidays, your service will be delayed by one day.
- Subscription recycle is available through CGS.
