Hancock County





UNITED CONSULTING has been retained by the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization, the town of McCordsville, and Hancock County to conduct a Corridor Study/Environmental Analysis for the Hancock County Road 600 West (Mount Comfort Road) corridor extending from I-70 to County Road 1000 North (96th Street).

The main purposes for this study will be to identify a preferred alternative for future improvements along the County Road 600 West (Mount Comfort Road) corridor and to identify potential environmental concerns that may be present. It is anticipated that most of the future improvements will utilize the existing alignment along County Road 600 West. However, a segment consisting of new alignment will be investigated that will allow County Road 600 West (Mount Comfort Road) to bypass the town of McCordsville. This new alignment will be defined to a level that will allow local officials in Hancock County and the town of McCordsville to begin making necessary amendments to their Thoroughfare Plans.

Citizens will be invited to comment on the preferred alignment during a public information meeting to be held in spring 2010. It is expected that the Corridor Study/Environmental Analysis will be completed shortly thereafter.
